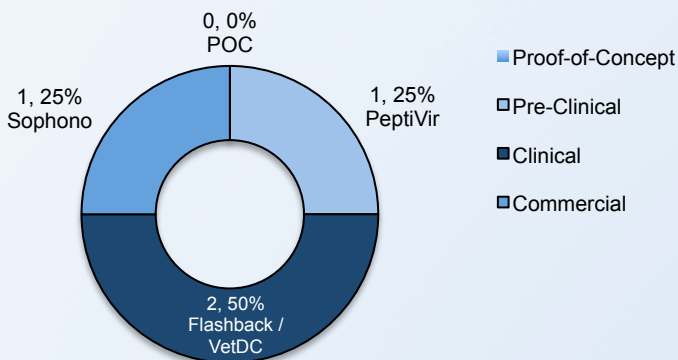


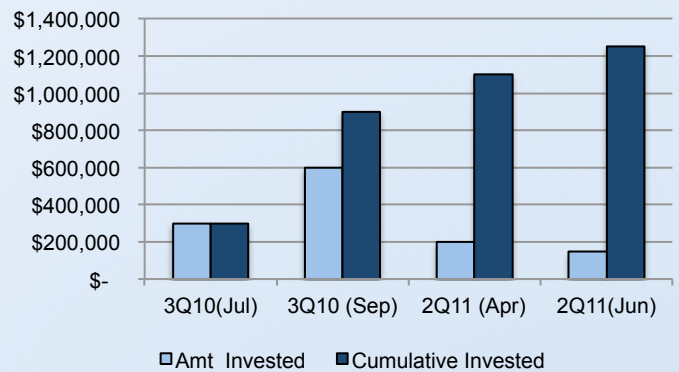


Founded in 2009, the Colorado Institute for Drug, Device and Diagnostic Development is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit charitable organization whose mission is to advance the Colorado bioscience ecosystem through company creation and job growth. Since inception CID4 has deployed capital in four existing, or co-founded de novo entities, that are therapeutic, medical device or diagnostic in focus. A total of \$1,250,000 has been put to work which has been leveraged to help raise an additional \$2,200,000 in follow-on capital. The CID4 portfolio companies have created 27 cumulative direct jobs, and using the common economic development 3X multiplier are responsible for an additional 54 indirect jobs.

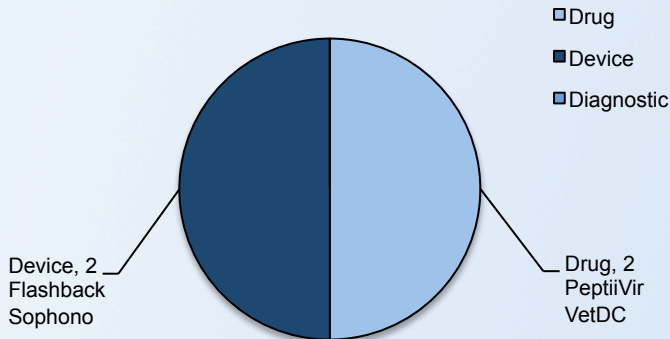
Company Stage @ Investment; as-of 4Q11



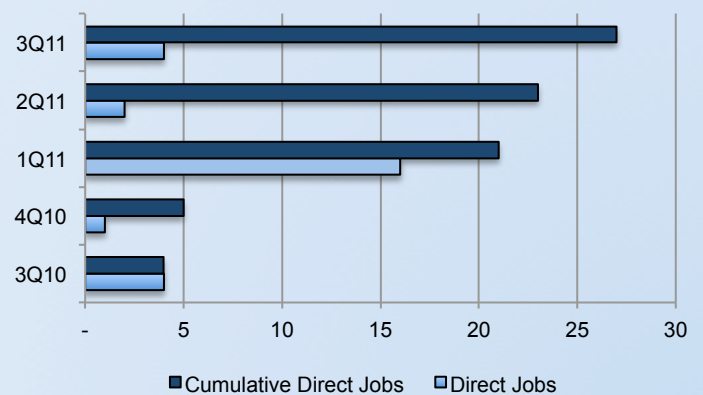
Invested Capital & Cumulative; as-of 4Q11



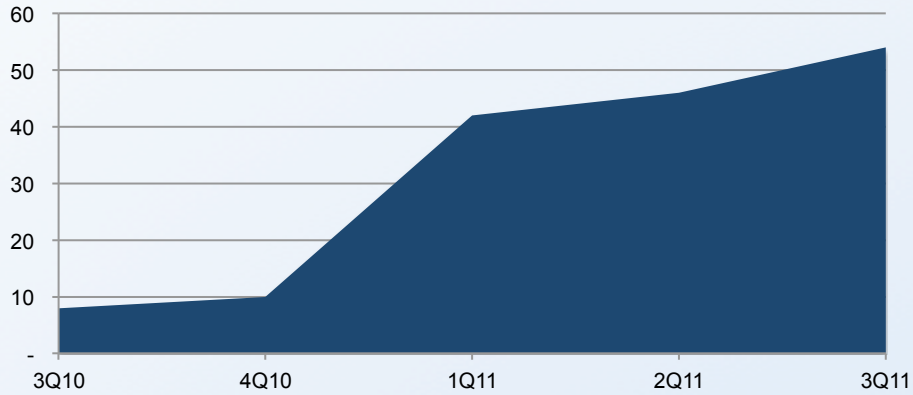
Investment by Sector Breakout; as-of 4Q11



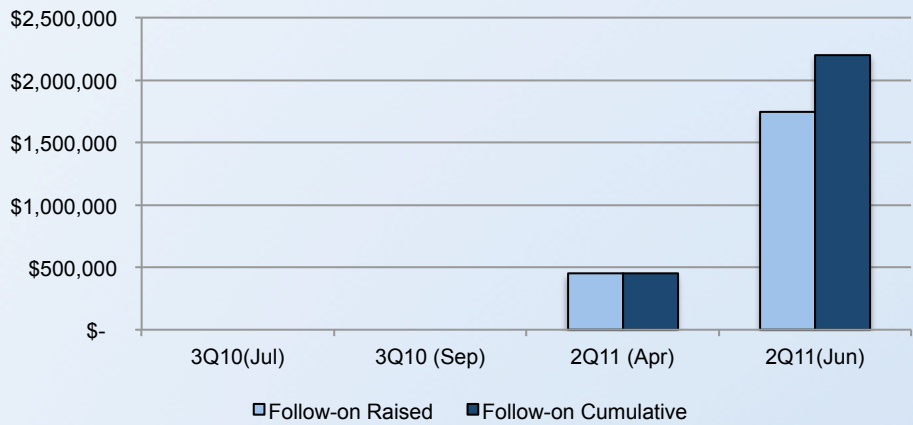
Job Creation (Direct); as-of 4Q11
